----- GENEALOGICAL REPORT

We still haven't found the christening for William Turley, father of Theodore and son of Joseph. However, we still haven't read all the films available for places listed as places of birth of Turley men living in the Sedgley-Losaley area at the time of the 1851 census. We have ordered 2 of these films and will read them and order more as we can. Evidence points strongly to the area along the rivers in Worcestershire as the best place to search. The Turley men seem to have moved from blast furnace to blast furnace along the rivers and did not stay in any place very long, other than Sedgley. We seem to have found the Benjamin Turley who was buried at St. Pauls in Birmingham (the place where William Turley was buried) at Wolverley in Worcestershire. We have searched many parishes in this area....we have a list of 42 parishes which have been searched.

At present we feel that we are on the right lead to trace the lineage of Ann Bolton who married Joseph Kimberley. The only Ann Bolton who we feel fits at all was the daughter of William Bolton who possibly was born at Lichfield in Staffordshire. We have searched 2 of the 4 parishes in this city and have films ordered for the other 2.

Since the first of the year, we have found a marriage on the sealing line on the Kimberley Pedigree. This took place at Hattlebury, Worcestershire. Rich: Joyces of Ambresley (early spelling of Gabersley) and Francis Parrett 10 May 1596.

Possibly you will be interested in a report of the names cleared since the new sheets have been used, beginning Oct. 1, 1969. Genevieve Bushman and Widge Shelley have sent in some names and along with what I have sent, we have had 3,375 cleared. Under the present system, very few of these were eligible for the Family File, and they were

recently sealings for the brothers and sisters of ancestors. Some of the family groups on the pedigree came under the R-Tid Program and are not allowed to send them in for clearing. We have some family groups not in the Turkey book printed about 5 years ago. We also have entrance dates, copies of wills, etc. you likely do not have. If you can come to Woodruff, we will be very happy to show you our things.
